BEFORE YOU GO

Research & Reservations

- Book a pet-friendly cabin (like Hapey Cabin Rentals!)
- Confirm pet policies at restaurants/attractions
- Map out pet-friendly trails and parks
- Schedule a vet check-up if needed
- Confirm up-to-date ID tags and microchip info

Print or Save

- Vaccination records
- Emergency vet contacts in Gatlinburg
- A list of pet-friendly restaurants & trails
- This checklist!

WHAT TO PACK

Food & Hydration

- Dog food + travel food container
- Collapsible travel water bowls
- Bottled water for the drive or hikes
- Treats (plus extras!)

Comfort & Clean-Up

- Leash and backup leash
- Harness or carrier
- Poop bags
- Wipes or towel for muddy paws
- Dog bed or blanket
- Pet-safe bug spray or paw balm (seasonal)

WHAT TO PACK (cont.)

Fun & Relaxation

- Favorite toys or chew items
- Puzzle feeder or slow-bowl
- Sweater or cooling vest (seasonal)
- Crate or soft-sided kennel (if crate-trained)

ONCE YOU ARRIVE

At Your Cabin

- Set up a comfy pet space
- Walk your pup to explore the new surroundings
- Keep food/water in a consistent place
- Use leash or tie-out for safety on decks

Around Town

- Visit dog-friendly patios
- Check peak dining hours to avoid crowds
- Bring your leash and water bowl when heading out
- Plan outings with breaks and cool-down time

EXTRA TIPS

- Be mindful of hot pavement in summer and salt in winter
- Give your dog plenty of breaks—travel is tiring!
- Keep your phone charged for those adorable cabin porch pics
- Don't forget to relax—you're on vacation, too!
